APENS National Certification Exam Now ONLINE

The APENS Committee and the NCPEID are pleased to announce that the APENS National Exam is now available ONLINE! Candidates interested in taking the exam must first meet all the eligibility criteria, pay the exam fee and submit BOTH Part 1 and Part 2 of the APENS application before receiving access. The APENS Exam is available through the SUNY Cortland Black Board web site and uses the Respondus Lockdown Browser features to secure the exam and testing

APENS National Certification Exam Fee Increase

The NCPEID Executive Committee and Board have approved an increase in the APENS National Exam fee from \$150.00 to \$250.00 effective January 1, 2021. The current fee of 150.00 dollar will remain current through January 1, 2021. This is the first increase in the exam fee since 2010. The NCPEID Executive Board recognizes the impact any increase in fees has on its membership and on teachers and the Executive Board would like to remind those interested in becoming nationally certified in Adapted Physical Education that the CAPE certification is a 7 year certification. In addition, candidates who successfully pass the APENS exam and receive CAPE (Certified Adapted Physical Educator) status are also given a one-year free membership to the NCPEID and receive a one year subscription to Palaestra.
