

Delivery of Service Continuum Determining Least Restrictive Environment

1

General Physical Education Setting

No APE Service

No Accommodations or Modifications needed

2

General Physical Education Setting – Indirect Consult

The APE teacher consults with the GPE teacher on incorporating modifications and accommodations into the lessons.

3

General Physical Education Setting – Indirect and Direct Consultation Services

The APE teacher consults with the GPE teacher as indicated in number 2 and directly monitors the student's progress on a periodic basis

4

General Physical Education— Direct Service

Usually a co-teaching model, the APE teacher works with the student directly every time the student attends Physical Education

5

General Physical Education – Direct Pull-Out Services

The student attends the general Physical Education setting and is sometimes pulled out of GPE or pulled out another time during the day to receive one on one or small group APE services

6

Self-Contained Setting – Direct Service in Small Group Setting

The student receives their Physical Education credit in a small group setting with direct service from an APE teacher

7

Individualized Setting – Direct Service

Student receives one on one direct service with an APE teacher working on personal lifetime fitness and activity

8

Community Based Instruction – Direct Consultative Services

As a result of the nature and severity of an individual's health condition, APE services are provided in the community to develop an individualized fitness or activity program and monitor their successful engagement in the program.

(Includes instructional service in home or hospital)
